Vision and mission

Vzw MAMAFRIKA is a non-profit association from Belgium, born in by name in December 2018 and born by legal right in September 4th 2019 (BE0733.688.895).

The goal from this association is about supporting one or more *Sustainable Development Goals (United Nations, 2015)*. Our main goals is to improve health care for mothers and children in the OESO-country the Gambia. Above this main goal, we also are trying to reduce poverty and hunger.

The North Operation happens in Belgium, led by the Belgian Board in charge (page 1). They make the (crowd)funding happen, decide globally what project(s) they will fund and decide who will locally take the lead in this project.

The South Operation happens in the The Gambia, led by the Gambian Board in charge (page 1). They work out the projects and have partial ownership in these matters. They agree to lead the project by contract and share complete transparency with the Belgian Board.

Examples for possible projects are:

- Building a Mamafrika-house: This house will provide *free or cheap* housing for local health workers and Belgian volunteers
- High-risk training for health personal: resuscitation, observation, hemorrhages,...
- Supplying collected medical equipment and divide systematically over chosen health centra
- Improving or expanding the infrastructure of the facilities
- Renovation projects in Health centra/posts/hospitals

General rights and duties board members

Mamafrika is like “the child” of the president in charge. The president has got veto-right. If necessary and requested by the Belgian Board the vice-president will take the president’s place in case of absence, but *always without veto-right*.

Only the President and the Vice-president can request a meeting with the board. They will invite the board members by written invitation at least one week before the date.

At the committee meetings the spoken language is English if any Belgian nationality attends. If anyone don’t understand the agreements, him or her will be consulted in Mandinka.

All the board members are chosen by experience, trust and reliability. They also receive a Mamafrika t-shirt.

The Gambian board will honor the agreements on this document. All of their signature together will make the document legal.

The Gambian board members will have the right to vote on board committees and may all advice on projects and decisions.

The Gambian board will always be the first in line for a leading job in one of the projects.



The Gambian board members will contact the Belgian office in case of problems concerning Mamafrika projects by Whatsapp or e-mail stichtingmamafrika@outlook.com .

The Gambian board members are required to promote the future project(s).

Every board member, Gambian and Belgian, are vowed to spread the name and logo in the Gambia. They will ask people to follow the Mamafrika facebook page and/or Instagram page as a mental support.

The Gambian board members are allowed to introduce relatives or friends to work for a project if necessary and required. Staff will be chosen carefully, only with the Belgian Board's permission.

The Gambian board members will be discharged if the Belgian Board voted with legal reason or by the President's decision. Possible legal reasons are: fraude, disappointment, treason and/or unactivity. Discharge will only be possible by written letter, signed by the president OR all of the Belgian Board members. A copy of this signed letter will be kept in the Belgian office.

Specific position's rights in the Gambian Board

Vice-president:

- The vice-president is leading Mamafrika like the prudent man. The (Belgian) President has got a veto-right. If necessary and requested by the Belgian Board the Vice-President will take the President's place in case of absence, but always without veto-right.
- Only the President and the Vice-president can request a meeting with the Gambian board. They will invite the board members by written invitation at least one week before the date.
- The Vice-President leads the local meetings.
- The Vice-President receives verbal or written communication from the Belgian Board about a development project: Therefore he should be available on Whatsapp or e-mail.
- The Vice-President advises the Belgian Board concerning local cooperation and the local projects.
- The Vice-President is allowed to give assignments to any member in the Gambian Board, except concerning money issues. Money issues are the local Treasurer's concern.
- The Vice-President is allowed to request transparency from the Gambian Board and community workers about concerns, working progress,...
- The Vice-President solves reported problems during a project. In this matter he may consult the Belgian Board.
- In case the Belgian Board decided that the local Vice-President will lead a certain project, this will be contracted in written agreements (addendum).
- The Vice-President supports the projects by heart.



Treasurer:

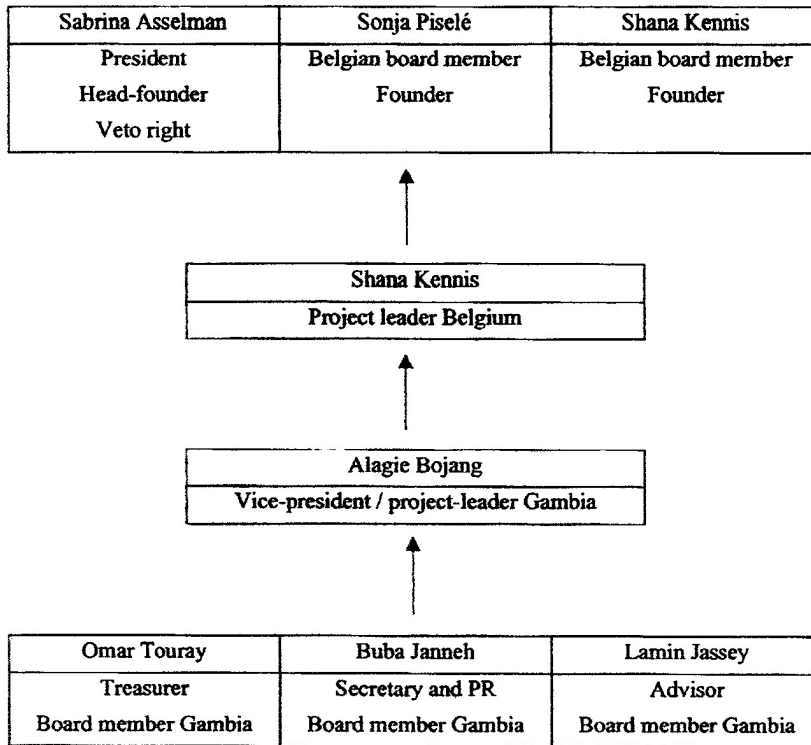
- The treasurer will always be in charge of money.
- The Belgian Board will transfer the money to his name. He will watch over it like the funds is his own and always concern about money matters. He will always recount to double check.
- The treasurer will always conduct prescriptions of transactions, withdrawals,... etc, scan them and send them as soon as possible to the Belgian Office stichtingmamafrika@outlook.com .
- The treasurer will always advice the best product concerning quality-cost in meetings and during projects.
- The treasurer should be easy available on Whatsapp or e-mail.

Secretary and PR:

- The Secretary will make sure the project's positive name is well spread.
- In case of any public presentation he will lead the public relation part: The Secretary will prepare how to make a project public to the crowd. He will check his (personal and/or business) contacts in the community to help him with any (press/crowd) conference.
- The Secretary is allowed to choose anyone from the Gambian board, including himself, to present the finished project to the crowd. The Secretary will for this matter always make the speech himself.
- The Secretary should be easy available on Whatsapp or e-mail.
- The Secretary will spread the attendance call for meetings to the Gambian board.
- The Secretary will setup a report after every meeting with notice of the new agreements and attended board members. He will use the writing paper of Mamafrika (this digital document he will receive from the Belgian office) and type out the report in the ASK Communication Center, on his own laptop or on any computer. The typed out report should be sent to the Belgian office stichtingmamafrika@outlook.com within 7 days after the meeting.
